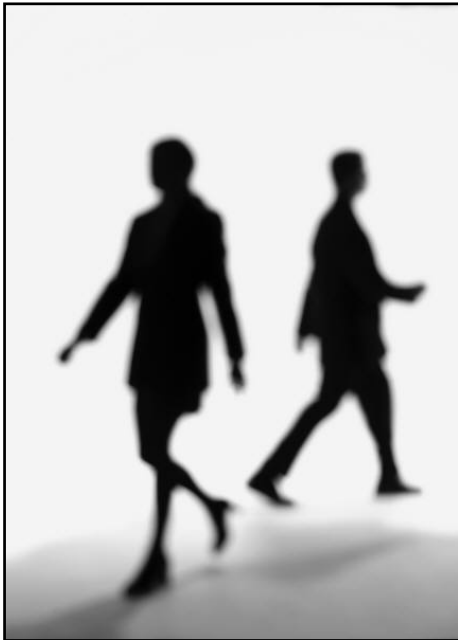


## How To Enter And Exit A Singing Audition



When entering a singing audition, make your introduction brief. Say your name and the title of the song you will be singing. Smile, be polite and act professional.

Make sure you and the accompanist are on the same page before you start. Wait for their cue, as well as the casting director to be ready. When the music starts, it's time to sing and your entrance is now over.

Depending on how well you audition, the casting director may ask you to sing multiple songs. Reason being, they enjoyed your performance and want to

see what else you can offer.

When you have finally finished say, thank you and be on your way. Give an extra thanks to the accompanist, especially if the music was on point and improved your audition. Leave a resume stapled to your headshot with the casting director or assistant and leave quietly.

Singing auditions will rarely have you wait around incase they want to hear you sing again. If they want to hear multiple songs, you will do them during your time. If a director does want to see you again, it will be at the callback. If you get that call, you did well and are now in the final running.
